

Dear Parents, Carers

We had to adapt our home learning provision to make it work for as many families as possible. Children are expected to complete home learning activities in a way that you can manage.

The grid below explains the work children in Year 1 to Year 6 will be expected to complete and the communication staff will have with you. The lessons will be available so that children can access them and revisit at any time.

Level 4 is covering a local or national lockdown.

<p><b>Level 1</b></p> <p>Isolation for a few days whilst someone in your house is waiting for a test result</p>	<p><b>Home learning tasks:</b> these have been set for the year group. They will also be on the website. Any additional reading. Online learning platforms such as TT Rockstars, Mathletics, Spelling Shed, Numbots and Spag.com. Please also use BBC Bitesize and Oak Academy.</p>	<p>Office staff to stay in contact to get an update.</p>	<p>Parents to phone the school should you need to speak to the class teacher about any learning.</p> <p>On return to school bring in any work completed to show your teacher.</p>
<p><b>Level 2</b></p> <p>Your child has been told to isolate for 10 – 14 days</p>	<p><b>Home learning tasks</b></p>	<p>The class teacher will email to discuss any learning with you.</p> <p>The teacher will email you if they do not hear from you or see any work.</p> <p>If required the teacher will email the children off with a time for a live chat through Teams.</p>	<p>Through email send photos of work completed for the teacher to assess and comment on.</p> <p>Children's work will be saved on the school server.</p>
<p><b>Level 3</b></p> <p>A high proportion of the class or year group has been told to isolate for 10-14 days.</p>	<p><b>Home learning tasks plus</b></p> <p>Through Teams, a teacher will deliver half an hour of teaching each day. These lessons will cover the teaching input for the maths and English lessons covered that day.</p> <p>Children will be asked to log in to Teams from their own email address.</p>	<p>A daily email from the class teacher- checking in and giving you the time of the live Teams lessons and/or the pre-recorded lessons.</p> <p>The teacher will send the daily maths and English lessons through Teams. Work will be set from the lessons.</p>	<p>Through email send photos of work completed for the teacher to assess and comment on.</p> <p>If the teacher needs to give individual feedback they will email you to arrange a time through Teams.</p>

		The teacher will email the children with a time for a live chat to support learning or well being. This will be done through Teams once a week.	Children's work will be saved on the school server.
<p><b>Level 4</b></p> <p>The whole class/year group or phase has been told to isolate for 10 – 14 days or there is a national or local lockdown.</p>	<p><b>Home learning tasks plus</b></p> <p>Through Teams, a teacher will send power-point lessons, some with pre-recorded voice overs each day. These lessons will cover English, maths and another area of learning every day. This will allow you to view the lessons at a time that suits you.</p> <p>Children will be asked to log in to Teams from their own email address.</p>	<p>A daily email from the class teacher-checking in and giving you the lessons being sent through Teams and any additional information.</p> <p>The teacher will add the lessons to Teams. Work will be set from the lessons.</p> <p>The teacher will email the children with a time for a live chat to support learning or well-being. This will be done through Teams as required.</p> <p><i>During a lockdown advice on national remote provisions will also be added to newsletters and the website.</i></p>	<p>Through email send photos of work completed for the teacher to assess and comment on.</p> <p>If the teacher needs to give individual feedback they will email you to arrange a time through Teams.</p> <p>Children's work will be saved in the Teams folder or through emails.</p>

All live sessions will have at least two members of staff and are recorded to safeguard the member of staff.

Parents please know that children cannot be in their bedrooms and must be appropriately dressed and a parent must be within ear shot of the live session. Children will be unable to remove each other, create their own teams or have private chat. The organiser will have control over the microphones.

Nursery and Reception teachers will continue to communicate with parents through Tapestry and provide daily lessons in phonics and maths and they will read a class story and ask questions about the story.
