

# Reception Spring Learning 26.3.21– 12.4.21

You were given a step by step sheet on making a jam sandwich. Follow the sheet and try to make a sandwich on your own. What do you need to do first, next, last etc.



Read a book every day with your grown up using your phonic knowledge! Look for known digraphs and trigraphs and talk about what is happening in the story—can you tell your adult what you think will happen next?



Go on a number hunt. Have a walk around your local area. Look at the door numbers and the numbers on the car registration plate. What numbers do you recognise? Can you make a number sentence out of them?



Use the phonics phase 2 and 3 sound mats to practise your sounds and tricky words. Can you write some sentences containing these?



Play a game of hide and seek with your favourite toy. Get your grown up to hide your toy while you count to ten. When you find it, tell your grown up where the toy was e.g. “The teddy was under the table.”



Look up ‘Easter Cosmic Yoga’ on YouTube and participate in one of the videos relating to Spring and Easter.




**Get Baking!**
