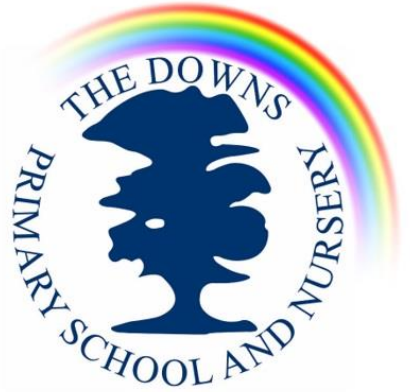

## **Expectations of Harlow LeisureZone**

**Please read the following expectations with your child before they go swimming as Harlow Leisurezone swimming instructors have the right to refuse entry to the pool.**

**The Leisurezone have measures in place to comply with social distancing, ALL students must comply with these guidelines or they will not be able to attend.**

- Boys should wear swimming trunks or swimming shorts with an inner lining and must not wear knee-length shorts.
- Girls should wear a one-piece swimming costume.
- Children with long hair (girls and boys) must wear a swimming hat.
- Children should not wear any jewellery.
- Children's behaviour must be good and sensible at all times, especially in the changing rooms.
- At the poolside, the children must walk carefully and sensibly to and from their lessons.
- When it is time to leave the pool children must leave the pool straightaway as the next lesson will start promptly.
